At Reepham High School we value the importance of uniform and the sense of community that it provides.

We expect all pupils to wear full uniform for the duration of the academic year.

Hijabs	A plain black or dark blue head covering may be worn for religious reasons.
Outdoor	No hoodies to be worn on the school site. Outdoor coats only over

Uniform expectations-

To ensure that pupils wear the correct uniform at all times, pupils are issued with a uniform card. The uniform card is issued every half term by their Form Tutor; members of staff sign the card if the pupil is not wearing the correct uniform. If the pupil has three signatures from staff, refuses to hand over their uniform card, or loses it, they will receive a 15-minute lunchtime detention. We also have available spare uniform for pupils to wear should they need it.
